- Some knowledge of qualitative and/or quantitative analysis, or a strong desire to learn
- A self-starter with strong organizational and time management skills
- Has the ability to manage multiple priorities within extremely tight deadlines
- Knowledge of the youth workforce development sector is an asset
- Has an entrepreneurial mindset and the ability to think outside the box
- Strong verbal and written communication
- Proficiency in Microsoft Office (including Word, Excel, Access, Outlook, PowerPoint) and Google Suite tools (google drive, docs, sheets etc) and social media
